Healing from Loss

The Caring Place supports families who are grieving after a death, but children and adults can also grieve after losses like divorce, a friend moving away, or the incarceration of a family member. No matter the loss, allow your child to know it is okay to feel grief. Be willing to admit when you are grieving too. Listen to their questions- it means more than having the answers.
